TAMSYN IMISON AWARD for HALESWORTH COMMUNITY PROJECT OF THE YEAR

The award shall consist of a glass bowl engraved by Lesley Pyke in memory of Dame Tamsyn Imison DBE who gave money for its creation. It shall be held for one year from the date of the award by the winners whose names shall be exhibited on its plinth. It shall be exhibited during the year in the Halesworth County Library. The winner shall not be eligible for the award in the immediately succeeding year.

The winners shall be the formal or informal group of volunteers or an individual based in Halesworth who undertook a project during the relevant calendar year which in the opinion of the judges was most worthy of recognition for its contribution to the quality of life in Halesworth in the year in question

There shall be three judges nominated respectively by the Town Council, the Cutler's Hill Surgery and the Edgar Sewter Primary School. Presently the judge representing the Council is Peter Dutton, the judge representing the Surgery is Dr.Craik, and the judge representing Edgar Sewter School is Miss Milk. In the event of any one of these bodies being unable to find a nominee the two remaining judges shall co-opt a third. Once nominated, judges shall serve as long as they are willing to.

The judges shall only consider those projects that have been formally nominated by at least two people currently resident or employed within an area extending five miles in all directions from St Mary's Church, Halesworth. Nomination forms (sample attached) will be available from the County Library in Halesworth. Eligible Groups may nominate themselves. Nominations will open on September 18th the anniversary of Tamsyn's death and will close at midnight on February 1st of the succeeding year. The award will be made on the following May 1st Tamsyn Imison's birthday. The judges may ask entrants for additional information about the impact their project has had on community life in the year in question. The judge's decision will be final.
